

## Champagne, Rosé Champagne & Sparkling Wine

- Prosecco, Sant' Orsola, Italy 125ml £7.00  
Made with 100% Prosecco and has a typical fruit spectrum of apples, pears and a hint of peach 750ml
- 1 Prosecco Extra Dry, Fantinel, Italy £25.00  
Fresh, dry and fruity. A pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral-based hints. A smooth, velvety and poetic flavour.
  - 2 Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut, Champagne £40.00  
Elaborate richness of mainly Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier evolves into an exceptional maturity laden with concentrated elegance. 125ml £9.00
  - 3 Taittinger Brut Réserve, Champagne £45.00  
Perhaps the lightest and most elegant of the Grand Marque Champagnes, an intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance from a predominance of Chardonnay.
  - 4 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne £50.00  
Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.
  - 5 Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé, Champagne £60.00  
Luminous, fresh, pink with initial aromas of red fruits leading to dried fruits and biscuit notes.
  - 6 Perrier-Jouët Blason Rosé, Champagne £70.00  
Copper-tinged, salmon pink with redcurrants on the nose and a mineral character.
  - 7 Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut, Champagne £80.00  
The briefest liaison with grape skins tantalisingly leaves this delicate colour yet exudes a floral fragrance evolving soft red berry richness.

- 8 Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque Brut, Champagne £120.00  
A prestige cuvée renowned for great length and elegance, these bubbles are also bursting with seductive, ripe berry richness.
  - 9 Dom Pérignon Brut £125.00  
Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.

- 10 Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, San Floriano, Italy £18.00  
Delicate flavours of apples and pears on a refreshingly dry palate. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
  - 11 Errázuriz Sauvignon Blanc, Casablanca Valley, Chile £18.00  
Dry with medium intensity and hints of apple and pineapple. Lots of fresh citrus zest to give a lift on the palate. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
  - 12 Errázuriz Unoaked Chardonnay, Casablanca Valley £18.00  
Fresh and lemony, unoaked Chardonnay from Chile with good mouthfeel and ripe, refreshing acidity. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
  - 13 Rare Vineyards Marsanne-Viognier, Pays d'Oc £18.00  
Soft and aromatic with notes of peach blossom and citrus on the deliciously refreshing finish. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
  - 14 Vidal Estate Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand £18.00  
A fine example of the Riesling grape, showing lime and floral aromas combined with the minerality and citrus fruit flavours typical of the grape in an off-dry, 'New World' style.
  - 15 Cullinan View Chenin Blanc, Robertson, South Africa £18.00  
Deliciously fresh and creamy with peachy fruit character. A classic South African style.
  - 16 Torres Viña Esmeralda, Spain £18.50  
Blending aromatic Muscat with the spicy Gewürztraminer results in this popular dry white which is both floral and fragrant.
  - 17 Pinot Grigio Collio Sant' Helena, Fantinel £25.00  
Wonderful aromas of freshly dried hay, pear and honeyed pineapple enveloped in creamy almond.
  - 18 Gavi di Gavi la Toledana, Villa Lanata, Italy £26.00  
This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints, dry but not austere.
  - 19 Chablis, Paul Deloux, France £27.50  
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.
  - 20 Villa Maria Clifford Bay Reserve Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand £28.50  
The Awatere Valley produces fruit with all this intense concentration of passion fruit and gooseberry flavours and hints of lime.
  - 21 Pouilly-Fumé La Ralotte, Adrien Maréchal, France £30.00  
Classic Loire white with fresh gooseberries and a touch of green pepper.
  - 22 Sancerre La Fuzelle, Adrien Maréchal, France £30.00  
Distinctively elegant. Laden with racy crispness and abundant gooseberry crunch.
  - 23 Chablis 1er Cru Vosgros, Gilbert Picq et Fils, France £40.00  
Delicate floral aromas and classic minerality characterise this excellent Premier Cru from a distinguished family grower.
  - 24 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot, Clos de la Chapelle, Domaine Duc de Magenta, Louis Jadot, France £75.00  
A fine wine that consistently exudes a warm buttery style, full of ripe nectarine and citrus richness from this Jadot-managed walled vineyard.

- 25 Boschendal Pavillion Shiraz Rosé, Coastal Region South Africa £18.00  
Ripe strawberry on the nose with citrus peel notes, the palate is slightly off-dry with a hint of richness. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
- 26 Torres de Casta Rosado, Spain £18.50  
Dry and refreshing made in a modern style from Garnacha Tinto and Cariñena grapes. Packed with the aromas and tastes of fresh summer fruits.

## Red by the bottle

- 27 Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France, France £18.00  
From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
- 28 Errázuriz Merlot, Curicó Valley, Chile £18.00  
An easy-drinking style from the cooler Curicó region, which produces an intensely aromatic dry wine with soft tannins and lots of berry fruit. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
- 29 Rare Vineyards Malbec, Pays d'Oc, France £18.00  
Having achieved fame in Argentina, Malbec returns home. Lovely violet aromas, solid fruit flavours and a splash of spiced oak. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
- 30 Nederburg The Manor Shiraz, Western Cape £18.00  
An abundance of prunes and oak-spice aromas; met on the palate by flavours of ripe plums and cherries. 250ml £6.20 175ml £4.80
- 31 Veramonte Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Maipo Valley, Chile £18.50  
Rich blackcurrants with a dash of spice. Very smooth and pronounced with a super balance and long lingering finish.
- 32 Côtes du Rhône, Les Rabassières £20.00  
Red-berry fruit and a touch of spice followed by soft, round crushed blackcurrants overlaid with cinnamon and vanilla.
- 33 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Spain £22.00  
Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.
- 34 Fortius Reserva, Navarra, Spain £22.50  
A powerful partnership of Tempranillo and Cabernet Sauvignon, laden with richly spiced red berries and generous barrique character.
- 35 Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin, France £23.50  
The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 36 Oomoo Grenache-Shiraz-Mourvèdre, McLaren Vale £25.00  
Intense and typical of McLaren Vale with dark berry, savoury and chocolate flavours backed by spicy oak notes.
- 37 Whirlpool Reach Pinot Noir Tamar River, Tasmania £25.00  
Redcurrant, herbs and wild strawberry aromas, with red cherry, raspberry and rubbed sage following on the palate.
- 38 Barbera d'Alba Suculé, Villa Lanata, Italy £30.00  
Hand-picked Barbera grapes from this estate exude ripe black cherry softness with a rich spicy finish. Full-bodied and rich mellow flavour.
- 39 Château des Bardes, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru £30.00  
The wine has rich, fruit aromas; juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla-toastiness from time spent in oak.
- 40 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Prince du Logis, Pierre de Laville £32.00  
Bright, solid, powerful fruit, overlaid with warm spice and notes of leather.
- 41 Villa Maria Pinot Noir Reserve, Marlborough, New Zealand £39.50  
Hand harvested and fermented in open top fermenters before ageing in French oak barrels for 10 months. Rich and fleshy with the seductive, silky smoothness special to Pinot Noir.
- 42 Barolo Lo Zoccolaio, Villa Lanata, Italy £44.00  
Specially selected Nebbiolo grapes give heady aromas of violets and bramble berry characters enveloped in large oak barrique complexity.
- 43 Saint Joseph, Le Prieuré, Jean-Luc Colombo £45.00  
A full-bodied wine with aromas of small ripe black fruits, liquorice and spices, showing well-integrated tannins on the generous finish.
- 44 Gevrey-Chambertin, Louis Jadot, France £50.00  
The name of the producer in this village guarantees this full rich structure with intense red berry vibrancy and a mellow long lasting character.
- 45 Barossa Valley Estate E&E Black Pepper Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia £75.00  
Developing a real sense of pedigree with these intense blackberry depths and generous sweet spices, enfolded by harmonious barrique character.
